Wine - Sparkling

13 / 65 NV Johansen Wines Chardonnay base Tumbarumba
 Campbell Meeks

The Johansen and Southwell families have been growing grapes for highly acclaimed wineries in Australia. This wine, which is from their own range, shows fresh flavours of granny smith apples, white grapefruit and peach, while displaying the depth of flavour that we love about Tumbarumba Chardonnay.

23 / 130 2016 Gallagher Wines “Blanc de Blanc” Jeir
 Chadonnay Canberra District
 Greg Gallagher

Making wine since the 1970s, Greg’s Blanc de Blanc is a great example of his meticulous approach to winemaking. Made in the traditional method, this current vintage was aged for 7 years and developed beautiful aromas of honeydew melon, buttery pastry and a creamy texture.

Wine - White

17 / 80 2022 Rowlee “Single Vineyard” Riesling Nashdale,
 Nicole Samodol & James Manny Orange Region

Handpicking from an eight hectare vineyard situated on Orange’s ancient volcanic soils, the team at Rowlee focus on small batch winemaking with sustainable practices. The wine has aromas of lime, rose petal and dried herbs, while on the first sip we notice soft textures with flavours of lemon drops and pine lime.

13 / 60 2022 The Little Wine Company Pecorino Broke,
 Suzanne & Ian Little Hunter Valley

Suzanne and Ian, both from winemaking backgrounds, joined forces in 2000. With fruit from the only vineyard that grows Pecorino, they continue their pioneering role in using alternative varieties. The wine boasts with flavours of juicy pears, pink lady apple and preserved lemon, while flavours of pepper and fennel add complexity and texture.

Rosé & Amber

14 / 65 2023 Wild Wren Rosé Merlot

Previously owner and co-founder of Gundog Estate, Renee created her own label in the Hunter Valley with her first vintage being 2021. This Rosé shows aromas of rose petals, strawberries, cream and delicate flavours of tart red fruit with a savoury dry finish.

17 / 82 2023 Sabi Wabi “Sugi” Semillon
Peta Kotz Hunter Valley
Region

Peta, a Young Gun Of Wine 2022 - Winemaker’s Choice winner, is producing small batch, low-intervention wines. The “Sugi” was fermented on skins for 2 weeks, giving it texture and the right amount of saltiness while still displaying delicate aromas of white flowers and lemon myrtle.

17 / 85 2016 Stockman’s Ridge Wines “Outlaw”
Pinot Noir Lidster
Jonathan Hambrook & Will Rikard-Bell Orange Region

Listed as a ‘Top Vineyards’ finalists by the Young Gun of Wine awards 2024, the team’s main goal is to create a sustainable eco-vineyard. This is a broody and complex pinot noir, which has taken on aromas of candied cherries, dried herbs and earth.

13 / 60 2022 Mercer Wines Montepulciano
Aaron Mercer Central Ranges
Orange Region

Based in the Hunter Valley, Aaron makes wines from a variety of areas in NSW, focussing on organic and preservative-free winemaking. Originally from the Abruzzo region in Italy, this medium body wine boasts dark juicy fruits, chocolate tones and cola.

Nick honed his winemaking skills at various estates before founding his label in 2016. Inspired by classic Australian ‘clarets’, he honours the shiraz/cabernet blend heritage. Sourced from two Gundagai vineyards, it shows floral, blueberry, and milk chocolate aromas, with vibrant acidity and fresh fruit flavours on the palate.

21 / 100 2009 Wimbairi Wines “First Vines”

Scott and Sarah are dedicated to showcasing the distinctive character of each wine they make. Produced solely from first vines planted 1988, this special release has intense flavours of plum and macerated dark berries with elegant minty overtones. Only three barrels were made.
